The first Labor Day was held in 1882. Its origins stem from the desire of the Central Labor Union to create a holiday for workers. It became a federal holiday in 1894. It was originally intended that the day would be filled with a street parade to allow the public to appreciate the work of the trade and labor organizations. After the parade, a festival was to be held to amuse local workers and their families. In later years, prominent men and women held speeches. This is less common now, but is sometimes seen in election years. One of the reasons for choosing to celebrate this on the first Monday in September was to add a holiday in the long gap between Independence Day and Thanksgiving. Frozen Money, Oh No!

Using a Trona Valley Visa® debit card is a safe and convenient way of accessing your money while on vacation. For security reasons, accounts can get frozen while you're away from home. Trona Valley wants to make sure your transactions are safe. There are two main reasons for frozen accounts. The first reason is fraud by criminals. The second reason is the suspicion of fraud when none has occurred. The first can be a relief, while the second can be a frustrating headache. Members can avoid the frustrations of a frozen account by letting Trona Valley know when and where they will be going. It's strongly advised to call

Trona Valley before you travel so it can be noted. If a fraud alert is triggered, the person investigating the issue will see the note and know that odd transactions are perfectly normal. Go ahead and enjoy your trip with confidence. This also applies to children going away to college and using their debit card.

Free Service To Members

smsGuardian

smsGuardian is a new, free service that uses text messages to enable you to monitor debit card activity on your account. When you enroll your Trona Valley debit card, you will get a text alert when your card is used for:

- International Transactions
- Fuel Transactions
- Authorizations greater than \$500
- 8 or more transactions in 24 hours
- Transactions where your card is not present
- Out of state transactions



Additional Features Of smsGuardian

Respond immediately to unauthorized transactions. Your response will be routed to a fraud analyst for card blocking and follow up. Set your "Do Not Disturb" time, where messages are queued and sent to you outside of the time period you designated as "Do Not Disturb".
